- Today use any way you know how, to praise Our Father in Heaven and affirm the authority of Jesus over our affairs and especially the leadership of the nation.

Tuesday 3rd Jan. 2017: Confessing the sin of Rebellion

"Declare to my people their rebellion......For day after day they seek me out; they seem eager to know my ways, as if they were a nation that does what is right and has not forsaken the commands of its God......
Why have we fasted, they say and you have not seen it? Why have we humbled ourselves and you you

have not noticed?" Yet on the day of your fasting, you <u>do as you please</u> and exploit the workers" Isa. 58:1-4

- > On this day, Thank God for his word and agree with the word of rebuke through the prophet Isaiah.
- Confess the sin of rebellion, where we follow our heart desire and very little regard for God.

 Confess the sin of complacency where we as Kenyans do as we please without any regard for What He is saying in his word.
- Confess the sin of complacency where we as Kenyans do as we please without any regard for What He is saying in his word.
- At and individual level, examine yourself and ask God forgive you for following your own desires and not those of the LORD.
- Confess on behalf of Church for not seeking God but going ahead with plans are not in line with God's purposes.
- Confess the sins of rebellion that are rampant in this nation and ask God for mercy and not judgment on our nation.
- Thank Him for he is always ready to pardon and to reveal his plans and purposes Jer. 33:3
- > Declare that the purposes of God for Kenya in 2017 will prevail

Wed 4th Jan. 2017: Confessing the sin of exploitation of workers

"It is common knowledge that majority of Kenyans are hardworking. One needs to observe hundreds of workers walking to and from work very early in the morning and late in the evenings. If you live in high end areas in Kenya, you will notice a big group of workers who live in the slums always close to an high end residential walking to work and later walking home in the evening as another group reports in the evening as watchmen. What they make per day is only enough to feed on but not enough to save and so many are trapped in poverty cycle. In the homes, we have another group of house helps who spend their time with the babies and they are also paid little and mistreated and yet they are entrusted with these children.

"Yet on the day of your fasting, you do as you please and <u>exploit all your workers</u>" Isa.58:3b "Look! The Wages you failed to pay the workers who mowed your fields are crying out against you. The cries of the harvesters have reached the ears of the LORD Almighty" James 5:4

- Examine yourself in this area 2016 and confess as an individual if there is anyone you have exploited or failed to pay for work they have done.
- Confess on behalf of yourself, your family and church for this sin that displeases the LORD
- Make a resolution and ask God to help you to pay what you owe and to fight for justice in this area.
- Confess on behalf of the Christians in Churches who have failed to act or fight for the rights of the poor, so they have remained exploited.
- ➤ Kenya is known for having a big gap between the rich and the poor and hence exploitation is high.
- Confess the sin of exploitation in this country, and ask God to raise leaders in 2017 who will fight for just laws that do not trample on the right of workers.

Thursday Jan. 5th 2017: Restoration of Broken Relationships

If we want to have results and answered prayer then we have to work on our relationship with each other. When we have wronged and been wronged and not dealt with it, our prayers to God are in vain.

Unforgiveness blocks our communication with God. When we don't have love for one another, we cannot claim to love God. A clear horizontal relationship will determine successful vertical communication.

"Your fasting ends in quarrelling and strife and in striking each other with wicked fists. You cannot fast as you do today and expect to be heard on high" (Isa. 58:4)

- Examine yourself and see if there are people you have not forgiven or are carrying a grudge against. Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal to you unforgiveness or strive that could hinder your prayers.
- As the LORD reveals blockages to relationships. You many need to make steps and approach those that you have wronged or been wronged and ask for forgiveness so that your prayers will be heard.
- As a congregation examine your relationships with other congregations and what wrong attitude you may be having about them. As the Holy Spirit to reveal these things and as he does, confess and ask for right belief.
- You may need to look at your family members, what is your current level of communication? It is fitting that you who is a believer should take the first step in restoring relationships.
- As believers in Kenya we sometimes have held negative ethnicity, raising our tribes above our Christian Brothers. We betray each other during elections and speak against others simply because they belong to other tribes. Confess this sin and declare this time round, the Christians will not be divided by politicians along ethnic lines.
- > Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The Prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective. (James 5:16)
- > Declare that in 2017, the church in Kenya will speak with one voice and refuse to be dividend.

Friday 6th January 2017: Spiritual Revival in the Church and nation

"If you spend yourselves in behalf of the hungry and satisfy the needs of the oppressed, then your light will rise in the darkness and your night will become like the noonday" Isa. 58:10

- > Thank God for the many churches and individuals who remembered the poor in this Christmas festivities.
- Thank God for the many initiatives undertaken by Christian groups to reach the poor in this nation.
- We praise God for many congregations that now have ministries to the sick and to prisons.
- > Pray that many more will start to focus on the poor and the oppressed and will be at the forefront in fighting for social and economic justice.
- > Pray that your congregation in this year 2017, will work towards meeting the needs of the poor and examine yourself as an individual to see that you give towards the poor.
- As we fulfill these conditions, claim in Jesus name, that the difficult situations in your family, your congregation and in the nation, will be overcome.
- > Declare a breakthrough in the stalemate over the electoral process in this country.

➤ Dismantle the schemes of the evil one concerning this nation in 2017 and declare that God's will and leadership choices will prevail.

Saturday 7th January 2017 Godly Foundations

Your people will rebuild the ancient ruins and will raise up the age old foundations; You will be called Repairer of Broken Walls, Restorer of Streets with Dwellings" Isa. 58:12
