



PRAYERS FOR THE NATION- NATIONAL SECURITY

Deutronomy.33:12 Of Benjamin he said, “The beloved of the LORD dwells in safety. The High God surrounds him all day long, and dwells between his shoulders.”

Mon. 18th May. 2020: God’s Blessings

“Yea I will rejoice over them to do them good and I will plant them in the land assuredly with my whole heart and with my whole soul.” (Jeremiah 32: 41)

- i. Call upon the Holy Spirit to continue manifesting His presence in a great way in the church and in every place where Christ is being exalted. (Psa 9:11).
- ii. Pray that God will protect you when you pass through waters, through rivers and even when you walk through fire that you will not be burned, the flames will not set you ablaze (Isa 43:2)
- iii. Pray that Christ’s Presence will continue protecting this nation and Jesus will be magnified and exalted in the minds and hearts of believers.
- iv. Pray for the security of your family, relatives, neighbours, workmates, and business colleagues in Christ’s name.
- v. Pray that the Holy Spirit will break the chains of the enemy’s work against God’s children. Pray that there will be a transformation of the entire nation to support the work of missions to the rest of the world. Declare that Kenya will birth the Revival that is awaited.

Tue. 19th May 2020: Economic Security

“As for the rich in this present age, charge them not to be haughty, nor to set their hopes on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, who richly provides us with everything to enjoy. They are to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share, thus storing up treasure for themselves as a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of that which is truly life.” (1Timothy 6:17-19)

- i. Pray for increased productivity and profit in business and every income generating venture in Kenya even in these hard times.

- ii. Pray that God will provide Kenyans with enough resources in order to take care of their essential needs even in these difficult times.
- iii. Pray that God will bless Kenya with showers of financial revival upon all business ventures, from the Jua kali sector to the bigger businesses. Pray that the Lord will uplift the financial status of Kenyans.
- iv. Pray that Christ will give the wisdom and ability to understand righteousness and fair dealing in business and in all income generating endeavors. Refuse and deny the enemy access to finances, property and opportunities that belong to God's children.
- v. Pray that Kenyans will get godly counsel, knowledge and wisdom to manage their finances, be they little or much. Pray that Kenyans will learn to honor God with their finances and possessions. Pray that any missed opportunity, any diverted wealth or lost investment shall be returned to the believers even after the loss in this pandemic season.
- vi. Many Christians have suffered economically due to attacks from the evil one and from those being used as points of contact by the devil. In Yeshua's name, block and resist the evil one from accessing the wealth of God's children.
- vii. Pray that the loss experienced during this covid-19, from locust invasion to the floods will be recovered as God realigns the economy to favor those that will support his kingdom purposes.

Wed. 20th May. 2020 - Political Security

"When one rules over in righteousness, when he rules in the fear of God, he is like the light of morning at sunrise on a cloudless morning, like the brightness after rain that brings grass from the earth." (2 Sam 23.3b-4)

- i. Pray that Christ will win the hearts of our political leaders unto Himself so that they will lead this nation aright (2 Kings 6:21-22). Declare God's Word – that the political scenario this time round will be transformed to accomplish God's purposes
- ii. With the weapons of warfare that you have been given, bring down every wall, worldview and strongholds that keep politicians from knowing God. Refute every argument and pride that keeps them from accepting Christ. Invite the Holy Spirit to bring conviction on them so they will accept the gospel message. 2 Cor. 10:3-5
- iii. Pray that God's agenda of service to the people will become central in our political leaders. Pray that from the President, His Deputy, cabinet, Governors and all other leaders will have a heart of service especially in his season of great calamities. Pray that irresponsible leaders will be removed from office and replaced with servant leaders.
- iv. Call upon God to deliver our leaders from spiritual drowsiness and ask for blessings on their labour.

- v. Pray for a turnaround for leaders and that they will seek godly counsel from the believers in this sensitive time.
- vi. In the name of Yeshua, break the tendency of the political leaders to stir up tribal divisions and ethnic rivalry. Declare all the communities are loved equally by God and have a great role to play. Break in the name of Jesus the tribal alters that are serviced by witchcraft.
- vii. Pray for God will bring to bear greater levels of accountability and those leaders who have been involved in corruption and other crimes will be prosecuted. Pray that our justice system will in this season be transformed to deliver justice speedily.

Thur. 21st May. 2020 -Military security

“You therefore must endure hardship as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. No one engaged in warfare entangles himself with the affairs of this life, that he may please him who enlisted him as a soldier.” 2Tim.2:3-4

- i. *The current security threat from neighbouring countries especially Somalia and Ethiopia, is a concern to our military.* Pray that the Lord will give the military leaders wisdom, guidance and strengthen to respond appropriately.
- ii. Pray that in matters of guarding the nation, the military will discern rightly the season and act accordingly. Pray that God will indeed lift any veil that would blind the mind of military leaders. Pray that such leaders will depend on God for guidance.
- iii. Cancel in the name of Yeshuah any plans or strategies that are aimed at our nation. Pray for divine protection from the Lord on any member of the security forces. Declare that their lives are secure and they will protect the nation. and that God will use each one of them in protecting this nation.
- iv. Pray that the Lord will cause the military to uncover any plans and purpose aimed at harming this nation. Pray that all evil plans that could be at play, will be exposed and thwarted.
- v. In these times of threats and fears of terrorism and the plagues, pray that the military will find refuge in the Almighty God who will keep, strengthen, and give them wisdom in every step that they make.
- vi. Pray for a great revival to sweep across all the military men, and many to give their lives to Christ.

Friday 22nd May. 2020- Environmental security

“The wild animals honor me, the jackals and the owls, because I provide water in the desert and streams in the wasteland, to give drink to my people, my chosen, the people I formed for myself that they may proclaim my praise.” Isaiah 43:20-21

- i. *Environment is an important component in the development especially because many rely on water and land for their farming.* Pray for sufficient water and proper use of our available land. Pray that goodness and mercy shall follow Kenyans all the days of their lives and the people will choose to follow God all the days of their lives.
- ii. *Water resources are increasing being affected by agricultural chemicals and industrial wastes which has adversely affected many Kenyans.* Pray that those responsible in disposal of such chemicals will be good stewards of the environment. Pray that the bodies given the responsibility to enforce proper disposal will do so without fear of favor.
- iii. Call forth and declare the blessings and restoration of the freshwater Lakes Victoria, Nakuru, Naivasha, Turkana and all other water bodies in the country.
- iv. Pray for a solution to deal with rising levels of water and for settling those displaced by flooding to higher grounds. Pray that resources will be allocated to the county governments and they will focus on solving this humanitarian crisis.
- v. Jehovah is a covenant keeping God and He is merciful...Pray and ask God to save the nation of Kenya from further floods as He did during the time of Noah.
- vi. Habitats of many wildlife species in Kenya have been threatened by encroachment of man and poachers also are a threat to wildlife. Pray that God will dismantle the cartels that continue to support poaching of wildlife. Pray for successful prosecution and convictions as well as conversions to the faith of the poachers.
- vii. Pray for the protection and preservation of our wildlife and other natural resources. Pray against any outbreak of water borne diseases.

Sat. 23rd Mar. 2020 – Food Security

“If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give what is good to those who ask Him?” Mathew 7:11

- i. Current rains have brought floods and havoc in many parts of the nation. This will evidently affect food security. Pray for unique provisions in Jesus Name.

- ii. Food availability and food access is necessary in our lives. Pray that more and more Kenyans will improve their farming systems and gain strengthened market systems. Pray against the devourer and waster of fortunes in Jesus Name
- iii. Pray that the Holy Spirit will restrain evil powers assigned to destroy Kenyans through famine and plagues. Release blessings from Heaven upon every Kenyan.
- iv. High food prices have led to deterioration of food security in Kenya. Call upon the Holy Spirit to intervene and give guidance, provision and daily bread to every Kenyan.

Sun. 24th May. 2020 - Borders' security

"Then set aside for yourselves three cities centrally located in the land the LORD your God is giving you to possess. Build roads to them and divide into three parts the land the Lord your God is giving you as an inheritance, so that anyone who kills a man may flee there." Deutronomy.19:2-3

Borders are increasingly becoming security threats to our nation.

- i. Due to clashes between Somali Pro-government forces and the rebel fighters of Al-shabaab, there has been anxiety and insecurity at the Kenyan-somali border. Pray and nullify any plans and schemes against the peace, serenity and calm in Kenya.
- ii. Pray that the border closures that were announced by the President last week, will be effective not only in keeping the pandemic at bay but will also enhance security.
- iii. The water and pastureland conflict among the pastoralists living along Ethiopia-Kenya borders has recently seen many lives lost in Turkana, Marsabit and other northern Kenya Counties. Pray that this will come to an end. Paralyze in Jesus name all destructive plans made against the nation. Pray that all anti-Christ schemes will be thwarted and suppressed in Jesus Name.
- iv. A meeting between Kenyan leaders and those of our neighboring countries- underscored the importance of harmonious co-existence among communities living along the common borders. Call upon God and declare that the peace of God will be seen at our borders. Shatter every demonic trap laid at our borders in Jesus Name.
- v. Pray for the peace of Jerusalem and protection of Jews and their investments worldwide.
- vi. Thank God for His promise to cleanse the people of Africa and to bring the end time Revival. Declare that Africa will arise. Thank God for answers to our prayers.
