Mon. May, 4th 2020: Church as Light in Darkness

Wed. May, 6th 2020: Peace and Welfare of Prison Inmates

“For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me.” Mathew.25:35-36

- 1) This day I decree and declare that the LORD is my shepherd, I shall not be in want. He restores my soul. He guides me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.
- 2) Plead the blood of Jesus Christ upon all the correction centers in the land. Ask God to impart the virtue of peace and hope upon each individual inmate.

- 3) Pray for the health and well-being of their family and friends through this difficult time

Thur. May 7th 2020: God's counsel in this Period for our Leaders
