Re-digging the Wells of Revival in Kenya

“So Isaac moved away from there and encamped in the Valley of Gerar, where he settled. Isaac reopened the wells that had been dug in the time of his father Abraham, which the Philistines had stopped up after Abraham died, and he gave them the same names his father had given them. Isaac’s servants dug in the valley and discovered a well of fresh water there. But the herders of Gerar quarreled with those of Isaac and said, “The water is ours!” So he named the well Esek, because they disputed with him. Then they dug another well, but they quarreled over that one also; so he named it Sitnah. He moved on from there and dug another well, and no one quarreled over it. He named it Rehoboth, saying, “Now the LORD has given us room and we will flourish in the land.” (Genesis.26:17-22)

Monday 1st June 2020: Past Wells of Revival

“For a brief moment I abandoned you, but with deep compassion I will bring you back. In a surge of anger I hid my face from you for a moment, but with everlasting kindness I will have compassion on you,” says the LORD your Redeemer. (Isaiah 54:7-8)

- a) Thank the Lord for the spiritual life and revival that was here in the past in the different wells that God had opened. Thank Him for His grace poured out in our nation.
- b) Honour those who were used by God in the past, for their vision, obedience, sacrifice and achievements. Bless the Lord for this spiritual blessing that we have inherited from our spiritual fathers and mothers some of whom have already gone to glory.
- c) Confess and repent for the negative things we could have spoken against our fathers and mothers of revival; negatively exposing their weakness to the world around us.
- d) Repent and ask for forgiveness in identification with the specific sins that put an end to the spiritual fervor of the wells of revival.
- e) Mourn for many who have turned away from God. This is seen in places where the revival had sprung up from. Ask the Lord to forgive us and to pour afresh his Holy Spirit to revive us.
- f) Ask God in the name of Jesus Christ to remove any obstacle that is holding back the re-opening of wells of revival. **1 John 3:8**



- g) Ask to God to re-open all the wells of Kenya-those that may have remnant worshippers and those 'unknown wells' that only God remembers.
- h) Take time to pray for Israel-peace, and the People to recognize Yeshua Hamashiac as their awaited Messiah.

Tuesday 2nd June 2020: New Wells of Revival

"He moved on from there and dug another well, and no one quarreled over it. He named it Rehoboth,saying, "Now the LORD has given us room and we will flourish in the land." That day Isaac's servants came and told him about the well they had dug. They said, "We've found water!" He called it Shibah,-and to this day the name of the town has been Beersheba.-"
Genesis.26:22, 32

- a) *After reopening his father's wells. Isaac then moved on to dig new wells.* Today we ask God for new spiritual wells that were never dug by our fathers and mothers.
- b) *Pray that we will go beyond what they did relying on the foundation they laid, Pray that we will go deeper.*
- c) Pray for a brand new outpouring today! So that revival will come to areas that have never received spiritual refreshment. Pray that they will experience the awesome presence of the Holy Spirit. The driest places to receive the biggest spiritual soaking.
- d) Pray that our technology, transport infrastructure, social media and all channels of communication will be used to spread the gospel and grow His Kingdom in Kenya.
- e) Pray for a move of God across the entire our nation, to spread to other nations in the continent.
- f) Pray for the Gospel to be preached to every people group and language in the nation and for it to penetrate deep into the respective cultures.
- g) Pray for the Holy Spirit to raise a standard against the revival of satanic agendas and wickedness in our nation in 2020.
- h) Silence in the name of Jesus voices of division, violence, idolatry, immorality, infirmities, etc. and Declare that the voice of God will be heard over the land and the people bringing peace, love, hope, unity and prosperity.



Wednesday 3rd June 2020: Preparing Kenya Leadership for Revival

“Praise be to the LORD, who has not let us be torn by their teeth. We have escaped like a bird out of the fowler's snare; the snare has been broken, and we have escaped. Our help is in the name of the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth.” (Psalm.124:1)

- a) Give thanks to God for His protection, for he has fought our battles, and some so severe they would have killed us. He has protected and saved our nation from destruction by terrorists and unscrupulous merchants.
- b) Pray for the body of Jesus Christ to turn from all that is evil, and discredits the name of the Lord grieving the Holy Spirit.
- c) Pray that the centrality of the word of God and the truth will be established among all the believers in this season. That Jesus will open the scriptures to them to understand the season we are in.
- d) Thank God for President Uhuru Kenyatta and pray that the fear of God will come upon him and he will put his trust in God rather than alliances that may not yield much.
- e) Pray that the Spirit of God will rest on him and fully take control of his life making him to rule the nation with truth and justice.
- f) Pray that the Holy Spirit will brood over his heart and bring conviction. As you pray believe and allow this to happen. *The power of a righteous person is powerful and effective James 5:15*
- g) The leadership throne that the President is sitting on is from God and he has not been called to serve his father's gods or other agendas. Cancel in the name of Jesus the plans of those that are trying to divert him from the plans of God. Declare that the throne he sits on will serve God's purposes and agendas.
- h) Ask God to release the balm of Gilead upon our President and the Deputy President and to heal the wounds that are now so deep that only God can do it.
- i) Pray that doors would be opened for Believers who can give to the President Godly counsel and his desired succession direction that would allow for the Revival to begin here in Kenya.
- j) Pray that the mouth of the President and his Deputy will be used to release the counsel of God, His purpose and plan for each situation, each person and each thing in their hand.
- k) Prayerfully open doors of revival in the three arms of the government (Executive, Legislature & Judiciary) and other levels of leadership in the country.



Thursday 4th June 2020: Preparation for Revival

“Ask of Me and I will give the nations to you as an inheritance” Psalm.2:8

- a) Pray and ask God to prepare the hearts of Kenyans to hear and receive the message of the Kingdom and move away from religiosity.
- b) Pray for people to be set free from spiritual blindness caused by years of indoctrination by the Western culture , traditional religions, other occultic practices.
- c) Pray for provisions for pastors in this season and their eyes to look to God for guidance.
- d) Pray for protection for Christian workers, many of whom live in very dangerous situations, facing drug traffickers, hostile tribal peoples and religious persecution.
- e) Pray for God to raise up youths with a passion to reach the other youths with the message of hope in Yeshua’s name and using the social media and other platforms.
- f) Pray for God to prepare the hearts of the millions of unreached people in various regions of the nation to be open to the Gospel of the Kingdom.
- g) Pray that God will supernaturally work in these regions, revealing Himself through visions, dreams, miracles and other demonstrations of His power.
- h) Pray for God to expose false beliefs - (secularism, humanism, Non-Christian religions and cults)and for the true Gospel to be proclaimed.
- i) Ask the Lord to help the church to remain strong, faithful, focused and in right standing with God even when they cannot attend services as before.

Friday 5th June 2020: YOUTH

Young people are our most valuable natural resource. Their energy, creativity and mission mindedness are greatly needed for the next level of soul harvest. This energy must be directed constructively, which can only be done by seeking God. Satan wants to turn youthful energy into negative, destructive force....something that need to be arrested.

“I am the vine, you *are* the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.” John.15:5

- a) Thank God for the many youth he has blessed this nation with.



- b) Pray that the youth will commit their lives to Christ, be filled with His Spirit, and be baptized in His name.
- c) That they will recognize His name is above every name and confess by a life fully submitted to divine authority that He is the Lord of all.
- d) That they will learn to communicate with Christ and learn to depend on Him for everything.
- e) That they will understand the depth of God's love for them and will base their self-esteem and identity in Christ and not the standards of the world.
- f) Pray for God to fill them with His joy and that they will not pursue worldly pleasure.
- g) Pray and ask God to raise and connect them with right mentors and good role models.
- h) Ask God to deliver them from the patterns of this world and enjoin their hearts to walk in His patterns.
- i) Take authority in Jesus Name and break all relationship and networks that negatively impact the youths of Kenya.

Saturday 6th June 2020: Moral Purity/Values and Relations

“Cleanse me with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow. Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones you have crushed rejoice. Hide your face from my sins and blot out all my iniquity. Create in me a pure heart, O God, renew a steadfast spirit within me.” Psalm 51:7-10

- a) Thank God who has promised healing of the nation and her youth through the covenant blood of Jesus Christ.
- b) Pray that youth would develop strength of character to remain pure in this permissive society.
- c) That they will make right decisions about sex, drugs and worldly pleasures.-their only true safety is abstinence
- d) Pray for grace to defeat negative peer pressure and learn to make the right choices. That they will be wise in what is good and innocent in what is evil.
- e) That they will not just keep a set of rules, but desire to please God in all they do.
- f) That the word of God will be instilled in their hearts and that they will choose the obedience of in hating sin and loving His Holiness.



- g) That they will retain values that have made our nation and churches great.—learn to live Biblical principles of integrity and honesty-to be true, especially in relationships. **Titus 2.11-14**
- h) Pray that God would give them friends who are true, wholesome and mutually encouraging.

Sunday 7th June 2020: Mission Mindedness

“He said to them, “Go into the entire world and preach the gospel to all creation. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. Mark.16:15-16

- a) Thank God for the teens and the youth that is already engaged and active in spreading the Gospel.
- b) Pray that the youth will accept their divine mission in life-(they were born to be a witness for Jesus Christ and to disciple others. **Acts.1:8**)
- c) That they will become spiritual leaders and boldly, courageously stand up for what they believe and cherish.
- d) That they will become catalyst for revival in their, schools and communities. That they will accept roles of responsibility in these areas, showing that one can live for God in this ungodly world.
- e) Pray that they will have wisdom to choose relationships that would honor God.
- f) Pray for the youth to set their thoughts on what is true, noble, right, pure, lovely admirable, excellent and worthy of praise. **Phil. 3:8**
- g) Pray that teachers of the word will come forth and train the youths and children to obey and serve the LORD for the welfare of this nation.
- h) Pray That God would remember his remnant in the nation and the world and visit us again by pouring afresh his Spirit as he did on the Pentecost day over 2000 years ago. Pray that in this season, he will reveal his sons and daughter who be filled with power and courage to witness for his kingdom.
