Monday 14th Sept. 2020: Young people's revival

“What do you think? If a man owns a hundred sheep, and one of them wanders away, will he not leave the ninety nine on the hills and go looking for the one that wandered off? And if he finds it, I tell you the truth, he is happier about that one sheep than about the ninety. In the same way your Father in heaven is not willing that any of these little ones should be lost.” (Matt.18:12-14)

Most cases of crimes in the nation are committed by the young men and women in all classes of life; the learned as well as the unschooled, the rich as well as the disadvantaged.

1. Thank God for young men and women in every field in this country and even some in the Diaspora.
2. Since we know the mind of the father concerning each of the young people pray for them that they would turn to God and be healed.
3. That the Lord will heal the youth from the pain of broken dreams so that they can start dreaming again.
4. Ask for renewal of hope in the hearts of young people so that they will look forward to making a difference in life.
5. To develop confidence in the God given abilities, talents and dreams so that they can be innovative and produce products and services that will impact the society.
6. Pray for a renewal of godly values in the society so that hard work, honesty, innovation, integrity etc. are admired while negative values such as get-money-at all-costs, corruption, dishonesty, gambling, prostitution etc. can be overthrown from taking precedence in society.
7. Pray for the young men and women serving in the army, police, and other security organs. That God's favor and protection will be on all of them.

Tuesday 15th Sept. 2020: Alcohol and Substance Abuse by our young people

“Do not gaze at wine when it is red, when it sparkles in the cup, when it goes down smoothly! In the end it bites like a snake and poisons like a viper. Your eyes will see strange sights and your mind will imagine confusing things” (Prov. 23:31-33)

1. *Drunkenness leads to increased sense of helplessness and hopelessness that comes when people focus on their failure rather than their potential.* Pray that in the name of Jesus the spirits that bring dependence on alcohol and other vices to distract the young men and women from seeing the potential that lies hidden within them will be bound and sent away from Kenya.
2. Thank God for this season, that the government has shut down many bars and selling of alcohol is now limited.
3. Pray that many will take advantage of this season to quit the dependence on alcohol and will be set free completely.
4. Pray and ask God to extend His scepter of power to the church so the believers will be able to break and destroy the alcohol strongholds that are affecting many men and boys in this country.
5. Ask the LORD to burden leaders to enforce the Mututho laws and that these will be enforced throughout the country.
6. Pray that drug lords who are well known would be exposed, shamed and put behind bars for many years- the years that they have enslaved many young people.
7. Pray that the demonic covering that these wicked people use will be lifted and justice will be done.
8. Ask that the law enforcement agencies in this country would be reformed and they would do their jobs with diligence.
9. As we prepare to open learning institutions, – Pray for Schools’ administration that they would be alert and close all the channels being used by drug dealers to lure our young people into addiction.
10. *Abuse of alcohol and drugs have made some to become child molesters and abusers. Cases of defilement and violence in families have really increased; Many Young girls have become victims of the same people who otherwise are supposed to protect them. Prayerfully confess and repent of this sin against God and our children.*
11. Pray that the bondages that are leading to defilement of young people would be broken and people would be set free.

Wednesday 16th Sept. 2020: Respect, Honor and Submission to Authorities

**“Everyone must submit himself to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established. The authorities that exist have been established by God.”
(Romans.13:1)**

1. *As a nation we have continued to witness lots of disrespect for those who are in position of authority- children dishonoring parents, leaders disrespecting those over them, spiritual children bad mouthing their destiny instructors etc.* Confess and repent for this sin on behalf of the land and her people.
2. Pray for healing of those who have been afflicted by this scourge of tongue and strivings of men. **Job.5:21, Ps. 31:20**
3. Pray and ask God to restore and heal the dented and mutilated image of many in authority so that respect and honor is will be seen once again.
4. Pray that God will be the foundation of Kenya as a nation. This country will not be built by the constitution but by the hand of God. Pray that good laws will be enacted and followed so oppression of the people will come to an end.
5. That God will enlighten our leaders to give them a total mind shift suddenly and will desire to serve and not to amass wealth through corruption.
6. With the ongoing reshuffles; Pray for leaders who will manifest servant leadership to come into position of leadership at all levels: Government, political, policy and decision makers, planners, economic, and in the rest of the society.
7. Pray for men to receive a divine fathers anointing so as to be pillars in raising a society where our sons and daughters will know and experience the goodness of God.
8. Pray against the cloud of violence and death hanging over this nation and the continent. Pray for a covering of the blood of Jesus which speaks better things that the one of revenge.
9. Pray that that the Islam (spirit of the bond woman) will not prevail even through her many prayers, wishes and strategies concerning Africa.
10. Petition the Lord that in his mercy and sovereignty he will not to hand Kenya to the enemies of the cross but will take his position and occupy the central part in the nations Psyche.

Thursday 17th Sept. 2020 : Roads Transport

**“Do not accept a bribe, for a bribe blinds those who see and twists the words of the righteous”
(Exodus. 23:8)**

1. Confess and repent for the high levels of bribery and corruption that has characterized our road and transport industry. Pray for an overhaul of the leadership of this sector so that upright police officers will take their stand and influence others to say no to bribes.
2. Confess and repent for injustice done to Kenyans by the matatu industry. Pray that God will hear the many cries and the tears of many Kenyans that have continued to go before the throne of.

3. Pray that justice will be done in our courts and this will curtail the vices in the Matatu industry. There are people who have been maimed or lost their loved ones through careless driving from our public transport drivers. Some of them that have caused deaths yet they are still on the road driving while many families agonize as cases drag in court.
4. Confess and repent for the sins of immorality, drug trafficking, lawlessness, child abuse, carjacking and kidnappings prevalent in this industry. Ask the Lord to shine his light in the midst of the darkness and to expose the evil agenda and people who have infiltrated the industry as an avenue for propagating evil.
5. Invite the Lord in transport sector to bring a change in the industry. Sanity should prevail in the licensing offices and within the workforce- (Drivers and touts.)
6. Ask the Lord to frustrate all planned accidents and incidents on all means of transport during this month. Cry to God for safe roads. Ask God to save our country from further bloodshed through Road accidents.
7. Pray for divine, wisdom, insight, foresight and oversight for the transport attendants as they ferry people from one destination to the other. Pray that they will have value for life and remember every death on our roads affect a family.
8. Pray that the LORD will raise leaders with a passion to see sanity in our roads. People who will not rest until there is order in every corner and crevice of ministry of roads and transport.
9. Pray for an overhaul of the traffic department- that men and women of integrity will be elevated to positions of influence and given the goodwill that will enable them transform the sector.
10. Pray for a revival to take place and many of the people driving this industry will repent and turn over their lives to God.

Friday 18th Sept. 2020: There is power in Repentance

“Then I acknowledged my sins to you and did not cover my iniquity. I said “I will confess my transgressions to the Lord” and you forgave the guilt of my sin. (Psalms.32:5)

1. *If we confess our sins He is faithful and just to forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.* Pray that as the people of Kenya we shall learn the power of repentance that brings forgiveness.
2. Pray for forgiveness and reconciliation in families between brothers and sisters; children and parents; husbands and wives. Pray for your own families, mention those you know by name if you have issues in your own family. Seek restoration within your family if there are unsettled issues. Ask God for wisdom to resolve issues.

3. Pray for true patriotism in our country Kenya. Ask God to give us a love for our country and desire to teach it to our children. That we will always pray for our country and its people regularly in front of the very young so that they may learn to love their nation and its people.
4. Rededicate this nation to God. Cancel every sacrifice on Baal altars that may have been made over our nation, and call God to forgive our nation so that the devil may not have a foothold. **Eph. 4:27**
5. Pray that peace will continue to arise from every institution in the land and for God to raise men and women who by God's wisdom will broker peace between warring factions in the nation and Africa.
6. Ask God to divinely orchestrate a wind that will move from one end of this land to the other uprooting and sweeping away all legions of violence with their strongholds.
7. Pray for political stability and for economic revival and growth.
8. Pray for peace, cohesion and prosperity of Israel and her people. **Psalms.122:6**

Saturday 19th Sept. 2020: The Body of Christ

“On your walls, O Jerusalem, I have appointed watchmen; All day and all night they will never keep silent, You who remind the Lord, take no rest for yourselves; And give Him no rest until He establishes Jerusalem and makes her the praise of the earth.”(Isaiah 62:6- 7)

1. Thank God for our spiritual leaders. Take time to pray for their provision, protection and wellbeing.
2. Ask God to raise watchmen, intercessors, in the Church who will pray without ceasing until the Bride is made ready and Kenya becomes praise in the earth.
3. Pray that the Church will remain in humility, prayer and fasting so that God may heal every sector of our land.
4. Pray that God will heal this country of cancer disease. There are far too many people dying of this disease and the diagnosis is very late such that intervention is almost in vain. Ask God to heal our land of all manner of plaques.
5. Pray that we will pray until God begins to reveal great and awesome things that we would not otherwise have known. Ask God to give our scientists wisdom, understanding and knowledge of finding a cure for all the diseases that ail our people especially cancer. **Jer. 33:3**

6. Ask God to release a prophetic spirit among the believers so they can bring to life dead and barren situations like Ezekiel did for Israel. Pray that an exceedingly great army for the kingdom will rise in this land and Africa. **Ezek 37:10**
7. Pray for supernatural strength to prevail in prayer until every battle that the Church engages in Prayer is won. Otherwise we will have a situation like ...'the children are come to the birth, and there is no strength to deliver them.' **Isaiah 37:3**

Sunday 20th Sept. 2020: Thanks Giving

“Now I urge you to take some food. You need to survive. Not one of you will lose a single hair from his head.” (Acts.27:34)
