



## **PRAYERS FOR THE NATION**

### **THE UNITY OF THE CHURCH**

**7<sup>th</sup> To 13<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2020**

***Psalms.133 – How good and pleasant it is when brothers live together in unity! It is like precious oil poured on the head, running down on the beard, running down on Aaron’s beard, down the collar of his robes. It is as if the dew of Hermon were falling on Mount Zion. For there the LORD bestows His blessing, even life forevermore.***

#### **Monday 7<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2020: Dedicating the Season Sept. /Dec. 2020**

***“The seventh angel sounded his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, which said: The Kingdom of the world has become the Kingdom of our LORD and of his Christ, and He will reign for ever and ever.” Rev.11:15***

- a) Thank the Lord Jesus Christ the rock of our salvation through whom the Church has its foundation. Pray that all Babylonian foundations be destroyed and everything in the body of Christ to have its identity in Christ Jesus.
- b) Pray for a new season (Sept/Dec) accept God’s season for yourself, family and the church. Pray that god’s Purposes for you and the nation will prevail.
- c) Declare that throughout this season the name of Jesus Christ shall be great in our lives, the Church, Kenya and Africa.
- d) By the blood of Jesus Christ, redeem all the months of this last quarter of the year from any plan, agenda and programs of the enemy.
- e) Dedicate all the days of this season to God, and ask the Lord to fulfill His plans, purposes and intents concerning your life, family, Church, nation, neighboring countries and Africa.

#### **Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2020: Repentance for the sin of the People and the Nation**

***“Even now, declares the LORD, return to me with all your heart, with fasting and weeping and mourning. Rend your heart and not your garments. Return to the Lord your God, for He is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love, and He relents from sending calamity.” Joel.2:12-13***

- a) Confess and repent for the sins of the people and the nation. (Corruption, injustice, idolatry, immorality, abortion, homosexuality, betrayal, stealing, cheating, pride, disobedience, rebellion, manipulation, witchcraft etc.)
- b) Confess and repent for listening to the deception of the enemy rather than the voice of the Lord. (Copying and emulating ways that displeases God).
- c) Pray for God to strengthen the Ekklesia in Kenya and in our neighboring countries.
- d) Pray for God to give us a proper view of who He is. That we will stop worshipping human deities, wealth, human wisdom, our strength and abilities, glory and praise. Ask God to restore true worship in the house of the Lord and in the Nation.
- e) Pray for a new generation of young people to come forth who will move with mighty power. Pray for an explosion of the gifts of the Holy Spirit and the salvation of many. Pray that the LORD will shield His Ekklesia with divine wisdom, wealth, righteousness, excellence and integrity.
- f) Pray and Ask GOD to strengthen the church and to unite the believers to be able to uproot and bring to an end corruption, deception, human philosophy, pride, sexual immorality and perversion, envy, witchcraft, bloodshed, manipulation etc in the Church and in the Nation.

**Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2020: Unity of the Church Leadership**

***“Also in Judah the hand of God was on the people to give them unity of mind to carry out what the king and his officials had ordered, following the word of the LORD.” 2Chron. 30:12***

- a) Ask the Lord to pour the balm of Gilead-healing anointing upon His body and heal us of all waywardness and the pains of persecution.
- b) Pray for the unity of Bishops and Pastors of different denomination that they will work together for furtherance of the Kingdom of God.
- c) Pray that the Ekklesia would arise and be united and with one purpose—to see the healing of the people and the land and to usher in his kingdom.
- d) Pray for the Ekklesia to arise in prayer and action against the encroachment of false religion and detestable cultures in various aspects of our nations: education, politics, family unit and etc.
- e) Pray that the Church will be united and speak with one voice especially on National matters particularly the moral values.
- f) Pray that the voice of the believers in the Government will be heard and that they will take their stand as Daniel and his friends did and confronted the powers that be.

- g) That God will pour afresh His Spirit upon the remnant in the three arms of the government (Executive, Legislature and Judiciary) to reignite their passion for the plans and purposes of the King of kings in their areas of service.

#### **Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2020: Bringing down the Idol Worship in the Land**

***“Tell them this: These gods, who did not make the heavens and the earth, will perish from the earth and from under the heavens.” Jeremiah.10:11***

- a) Pray and ask God to come down destroy and wipe away idols, evil altars and forces of evil in every institution in the land.
- b) Ask God to overthrow all powers of darkness that have been standing against the Church.
- c) Let His power put to an end the arrogance of the haughty and humble the pride of the enemies of the Cross.
- d) Ask God to visit media industry and the market place and judge the actions of those who deliberately act as false prophets, teachers of wickedness, shepherds of new age ideologies etc.
- e) Pray for God to raise true Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Teachers, and Shepherds in the market place and media who will advance the agenda of the kingdom of God in Kenya.
- f) Ask God to extend the scepter of truth and righteousness over the Church and Nation and break the scepter of deception and false revelation.

#### **Friday 11<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2020: Wind of Revival over the Church in Kenya**

***“Babylon, the jewel of kingdoms, the glory of the Babylonians’ pride, will be overthrown by God like Sodom and Gomorrah.” Isaiah.13:19***

- a) Pray and ask God to release grace among many believers who have been battered by the storms of spirit of jezebel, that they will receive courage and strength from the Lord. Pray that they will be revived and none will die.
- b) Ask God to break all the evil nets that have been cast over the body of Christ. In His power deliver the righteous from the snare and traps that have been set for them.
- c) Pray for the wind of the Lord to blow through the Church and break every cedar of pride, animosity, strife, negative competition and etc. Pray that the Lord will clean the Church and separate the wheat from the chaff.

- d) Pray for the fire of God of Elijah to come down and consume all the evil programs and assignments of Satan and his agents planned against the servants of God and their families.
- e) Pray that God will give the control of media, politics, education and other sectors to the body of Christ so his kingdom will come to bear.
- f) *Africa for a long time has experienced civil unrest resulting to loss of life and livelihood of many.* Pray that the Church will be in the forefront to break this trend and the continent will experience peace, stability and spiritual growth.

### **Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2020: Ekklesia as the Light of the Nation**

**"You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven." Matthew.5:14-16**

- a) Pray that each Assembly (Ekklesia) will become a light and salt to the community. Pray for Christians to bear fruit and a fruit that lasts.
- b) Pray for the Christians to be rooted in the trinity. Ask God to revive the true believers and strengthen them with the Power of the Holy Spirit.
- c) Ask God to fill the Church with wealth and His divine revelation and power, to eliminate poverty in Kenya and in Africa.
- d) Pray and ask God to raise an effective praying Priesthood in the Ekklesia in Africa. Pray for the Bishops, Pastors, and ministers to embrace intercession and be involved in building prayer armies.
- e) Cry to God and ask Him to begin to elevate believers to operate at the level of Joseph, Daniel, Esther, Nehemiah, and Ezra.
- f) Ask God to give the Ekklesia the ability to carry the assignment given: purity of heart, humility, boldness, controlled speech, grace to weep before the lord and willingness to serve the nations.
- g) Ask God to reverse the curse of the enemy over the Ekklesia and bless her abundantly.
- h) Pray that the curses pronounced over this Nation and her people will be reversed and that Kenya, her neighbours and the countries in the Great lake regions will start walking in the paths of God's blessings.

- i) *There have been violent demonstrations in the nation of Ethiopia. Speak peace, love and tolerance amongst the various communities in Ethiopia. Declare that Ethiopia will stand united and will overcome this present challenge.*
- j) Ask God to protect the nation of Ethiopia by the Power in the name of Jesus. Cancel in that name all the wicked schemes hatched to divide this nation along ethnic lines. **Psalm.17:8-9**

**Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2020: An Army Advancing the Kingdom of God in the nation**

***“Remember me, O LORD, when you show favour to your people, come to my aid when you save them, that I may enjoy the prosperity of your chosen ones, that I may share in the joy of your nation and join your inheritance in giving praise.” Psalms.106:4-5***

- a) Ask Jehovah to restore the prophetic voice of the Church of Jesus Christ in the land. Ask God to make His arm revealed in the Body of Christ.
- b) Pray for God to raise platforms for believers to speak the good news of Jesus Christ and message of repentance and hope in various institutions and segments of this Nation.
- c) Ask God to raise an army of praying saints in all parts of this Nation and Africa, that will stand on the walls of their villages, towns, cities and nations until these areas become a places where his name is honored.
- d) Pray that the army of believers will arise and be filled with courage and boldness to declare the gospel to every village in the nation.
- e) Prayerfully invite the Lord Jesus to take his place and lead the believers to disciple the nation for his glory
- f) Thank God for answering our prayers the years.
- g) Declare that the kingdom of this nation will bow and welcome Jesus to be its King.
