6. Pray and ask God to strengthen his character, guard him against hurtful compromise, and give him a listening ear for the people he serves.

Nov. 28th 2020:- The Judiciary

“You shall not pervert justice; you shall not show partiality, nor take a bribe, for a bribe blinds the eyes of the wise and twists the words of the righteous.” Deutronomy.16:19

1. On behalf of this Nation, confess and repent for ways we have promoted unjust judges who rule according to personal opinion instead of moral truth.
2. Ask God to forgive us for allowing corruption and injustice to preside within our courts.
3. *The Lord is the Supreme Judge and Ruler over all*--Pray for the salvation of every judge in every courtroom throughout our nation.
4. Ask God to give them wise hearts and discerning minds that will interpret truth and uphold law according to the principles in His Word.
5. That they will represent Him with dignity and integrity with full accountability to God and the ones they serve.
6. That they will judge tenderly yet firmly for the needs and rights of those who cannot speak for themselves.
7. Pray for justice to prevail in all areas of the departments of law and justice in this country.
8. That God by His Spirit will supervise the transition of Chief Justice –David Maraga.
9. Ask the Judge of the Universe to appoint a righteous Judge—(one who is bold, with sound mind and good conscience to deliver decisions based on Biblical and moral values) as his successor.
10. Pray for God to expose all corruption and inequity in our judicial system.

Nov. 29th 2020: -Spiritual Leaders
