### Praying for the family

1. Thank God for the good times we have had with our families. Thank Him for allowing us enjoy each other’s company.
2. Ask God to preserve our good relationships, whenever, we are with our loved ones.
3. Pray for God to preserve the bond of love and peace in families so members will always look forward to being with each other again.
4. That God will teach us what it is to experience real joy and enable us to show each other what this means.
5. Thank God for allowing our leaders to reject the rebellious definitions of family so that families in Kenya remain as God ordained them formed by the union of man and woman. Pray that this will remain to be so and we will not give in to pressure from the West.
6. Pray that our minds will be renewed and we will be protected from hateful thoughts but instead that we we will seek peace so chaos in the family will be averted.
7. Thank God for stable families in our society that are nurturing healthy children who will bring stability to the nation.

8. Pray that God will be a part of every family in the nation and as he takes his role, members will dissociate themselves from affiliations that destroy the family foundations.
9. Pray for healthy families who have broken free renounced all evil affiliations from previous generations and evil altars erected to other gods and are cleansed by the blood of Yeshuah and from both maternal and paternal sides.

### 15<sup>th</sup> Dec. 2020:- PRAYERS FOR GUIDANCE

***Exodus 33:15. Then Moses said to him, “If your Presence does not go with us, do not send us up from here”***

1. Dedicate your family as an Ekklesia where God’s name is honored, revered and loved.
2. Pray that That God will guide your family and other families in the nation as they celebrate and connect with extended members of the family in this festive season. Pray that He YAHWEH will be the shield for every family members.
3. Pray that His presence will always go before his loved one in the families that choose him as their God.
4. Ask God to guide you each day as you walk through life with your family, wherever each one may be at. Pray that a new sense of purpose for your family will be experienced.
5. Pray for the release of vision--Heaven design into every homestead in the land.
6. Speak a covering of His Precious blood over each family unit in the land.
7. That God will guard homesteads that no harm will fall on them and that these homes will continue to be sanctuaries of blessings, comfort and love for each one of family members.
8. That the homesteads will be become restful places for tired bodies of each member at the end of every day.

9. That God will protect them as they rest at night and will allow no intruders or calamities to disturb their homes at night.
10. Pray for safety over our roads in this season. Cover all the black spots with the blood of Jesus. Plead that only the blood of Yashuah will speak over the land in this season.

**16<sup>th</sup> Dec. 2020:- FAMILY RESTORATION & STRENGTH.**

***“But Esau ran to meet Jacob and embraced him; he threw his arms around his neck and kissed him. And they wept. <sup>5</sup> Then Esau looked up and saw the women and children. “Who are these with you?” he asked. Jacob answered, “They are the children God has graciously given your servant.” <sup>6</sup> Then the female servants and their children approached and bowed down. <sup>7</sup> Next, Leah and her children came and bowed down. Last of all came Joseph and Rachel, and they too bowed down.” Genesis.33: 4-7***

1. Invite God to be at center of every family relationships in the land.
2. Pray for restoration of bonds that have been broken among family members.
3. Pray that God by His Spirit will cause relatives to reconcile with each other. That the Holy Spirit will surround them with God’s love and they will desire fellowship with one another above other things including property.
4. That the Holy Spirit will heal our hearts so we can love each other just as Christ loves us.
5. God will enable our families especially of believers to be as a triple-braided cord that cannot easily be broken.
6. That in times of trials and troubles, these families will look up to Him, as their source of strength and sustenance.
7. Pray that in these times of pandemic when families are facing trying times; God will give each individual family member endurance to overcome any obstacle that may come their way.
8. Ask God the Restorer, to restore everything lost in time, resources, finances, joy and happiness that families have lost this year and will wipe the tears of those who have lost their loved ones.
9. Pray and ask God to command His angels to begin to bear up individuals /families up in every area they have stumbled. Let the angels carry and place them in platforms and arena of blessings.
10. Pray and ask God to begin a move to anoint homes as his assemblies. That those who know the word will begin to lead others to Jesus. That churches will spring forth in homes as Jesus is invited into these homes.

17<sup>th</sup> Dec. 2020:- PEACE IN FAMILY

***“I will make a covenant of peace with them and rid the land of savage beasts so that they may live in the wilderness and sleep in the forests in safety.” Ezekiel.34:25***

1. Confess and repent for fights and bickering among family members even among believers.
2. Confess and repent for where we have let anger, strife and bitterness rule over our hearts hence ending up hurting our families.
3. Confess and repent for sins you have committed against your own family. Ask God to change your heart and make it truly loving.
4. That Father God will give us the grace to extend the same forgiveness we received through Christ to the members of our families whom may have hurt us. Pray we will receive grace to humble ourselves and seek forgiveness.
5. Ask God to heal the wounds in the hearts of those who have been wounded; the love in blood of Christ will deal with any deep seated anger and touch their hearts so that they will accept the pleas for forgiveness.
6. Pray for the peace and compassion of God to reign in our hearts and homes.
7. Ask the Prince of Peace who guards our hearts to always remind us to be peacemakers especially within our families.
8. Pray and ask God to deliver every family from the scourge that is brought by evil speaking and strivings of men.
9. Pray for salvation of entire families as we saw in the early church- that a new move of the Spirit of Jesus will brood over and bring salvation and healing in whole families and communities.

18<sup>th</sup> Dec. 2020:- UNITY IN FAMILY.

Where there is unity, God commands a blessing! It is such a simple principle. The enemy knows this and hence the reason he stirs up strife within families. We believe that this is the reason many homes are devoid of God's blessing, because of division. Family members are pitting and plotting against one another. If only we would unite, for there, lays God's blessing!

***“How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity! <sup>2</sup> It is like precious oil poured on the head, running down on the beard, running down on Aaron's beard, down on the collar of his robe. <sup>3</sup> It is as if the dew of Hermon were falling on Mount Zion. For there the LORD bestows his blessing, even life forevermore.” Psalm.133.***

1. Invite the Prince of peace to come into your heart home and route out every deep seated bitterness in your heart.
2. Declare that all forms of divisions and discord in families will be dispelled as families come under God. a
3. In Jesus Name, cast away all forms of pride and arrogance that stand in the way of peace and unity in your family and other families in the land.
4. The Merciful and forgiving Lord, help us to let go of all hurt and offence that has been inflicted on us by family members. Help us to love as you loved, even those that crucified you.
5. Ask God to help families to release the grudges and hatred that have been passed down from previous generations.
6. That as Father Has given us a clean slate by the blood of Christ that we will receive the grace to extend that same love to others.
7. That in this season of advent, the Holy Spirit will brood over families to renew love that has been lost among family members and bring them together. Ask God to open your heart and your eyes to be a catalyst for this. In Jesus' name.
8. Pray that our Heavenly Father would release a new vision for our families into our fathers and mothers who are the head of families. Pray that the rest of the family will support this so that families will accomplish their purposes.
9. Ask God to help us recognize that it is Him Who has organized His church and have placed each one of us exactly where we need to be to do His work and for His glory.
10. That God will help us to prioritize our calling within the body and to respect all members as God has called us to.
11. Pray and Ask God by His Spirit to bring unity to the body of Christ in the nation so his purposes and plan are accomplished.

**19<sup>th</sup> Dec. 2020:- HEALTH & WELLNESS.**

***“And ye shall serve the Lord your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee” Exodus 23:25.***

1. *We would suffer and perish if there is no physical and spiritual sound health in the family. Pray that God should send divine health to all of us.*

2. Pray for those that have diseases and ask God to destroy all forms of sickness in the name of Jesus. Pray that the great physician will bring comfort to those who are in physical pain.
3. Pray that God will stir up again the gift of healing from among his people and they will be used mightily to heal the sick and afflicted ones in the name of his son Jesus.
4. Pray for the Shalom of God to hover over families and result in healing of emotional trauma and give his people comfort and peace that transcends understanding.
5. Pray that through the blood of Yeshuah God will heal the hearts Kenyans of anger, hatred, strife, bitterness and un-forgiveness.
6. Ask God will to clear from the minds of people any doubt, anxiety, or depression and renew in them a peaceful spirit.
7. Release the righteous judgment of GOD over the altars of sicknesses, diseases, infirmities, drugs, alcoholism etc. Declare that it is time of healing and deliverance.
8. Pray for our spiritual health, that God will revive our prayer lives, revive our faith and all areas that have slumbered within us.

**20<sup>th</sup> Dec. 2020:- PROVISION & PROVIDENCE.**

Philippians 4:19 ***“But my God shall supply all your needs according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus”.***

1. Thank God for daily meeting the needs of all family UNITS and their individual members. Speak His blessings over all family members.
2. *We cannot serve both God and Money.* Pray for Forgiveness in area where we have misplaced our worship and our focus to worship money.
3. Pray and ask God to give knowledge to families on how they can improve their financial muscle. And how to handle their monies and material wealth to serve the Kingdom purposes.
4. Pray that in this difficult season Families will commit to rely on Jehovah Jireh for their divine provision.
5. That He will Show compassion and release mercy and wisdom on His ministers, their ministries as they lead their flock to follow the shepherd of their souls.

6. In these times of dire need, that the Lord will Grant all His ministers the grace to pursue His presence. Ask God to speak solution to their problems and need.
7. Ask God to baptize the believers with favour and spirit of diligence. That God will give them an undivided heart and mind to follow him.
8. Pray for God to give them divine ideas for wealth creation and that He will bless and prosper the work of their hands.
9. Rebuke the spirit of the devourer in our families; Declare that whatever we have sown, we will reap and enjoy.
10. Ask God to remove pride and arrogance among us but instead plant humility towards God.
11. Pray and ask God to remember his promises to the Jews all over the world and to gather them to their Messiah and to the Holy City Heavenly Jerusalem. Speak peace to Israel.
