WEDNESDAY 23RD DEC 2020: PRAYERS FOR THE ORHANS, WIDOWS AND THE OPPRESSED

“A father to the fatherless, a defender of the widows is God in his holy dwelling” Ps. 68:5

- a) Thank God for the love and compassion that he has over those who are fatherless
- b) Thank and Praise him for the defense that he offers to those who have no one to look to but to him.



- c) Pray that the Church will take position and protect, be more concerned and have greater appreciation of the value and dignity of widows, orphans and the fatherless amongst us.
- d) Pray that in this season of festivities God will move the heart of many and they will give and support this group of people who are disadvantaged by the loss of breadwinners.
- e) Pray that the power of Christ's love will bring lasting transformation in their lives.
- f) Pray that the Lord will hear the prayers of the widows, widowers, fatherless and orphans and answer them in His mercy and love.
- g) Declare that God's spirit will empower and inspire all widows and orphans and that shattered dreams and hopes will be revived and be achievable in Christ's name.

THURSDAY 24TH DEC. 2020: GOD'S PROTECTION OVER KENYA

- d) Pray for our Roads in this period festivities when many are tempted to drink and drive. Plead for God's mercy and protection against accidents.



- e) Pray for provision so that the many who have lost jobs and means of livelihood will find help and support to take them through the rough perches that they are going through

FRIDAY 25TH DEC. 2020: BIRTH OF JESUS THE MESSIAH

Luke.1:35 “The angel answered, “The Holy Spirit will come upon you and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the Holy One to be born will be called the Son of God.”

- a) Thank God our father who in his faithfulness and in fulfilling his covenantal promise to David, caused through the Power of the Holy Spirit, Jesus to be born of the Virgin Mary.

- e) As we celebrate the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ, Pray for God to fill the mouths of Christians with his word, renounce fear, and give them boldness to share the Good News of Jesus Christ to the “lost”.
- f) Pray that the joy of the LORD will fill every believer in the land as they celebrate and praise YAHWEH who love the world and gave his son as a ransom so that all who believe in him will have eternal life.

SATURDAY 26TH DEC. 2020: RIGHTEOUS REMNANT

“Then the angel said to him, Gird yourself and tie on your sandals, and so he did. And he said to him, Put on your garments and follow me. So he went out and followed him.....”Acts.12:8-9

- a) Pray that God will defend the remnant and their investments by His name and will cause the angel of destruction to pass over.



- b) Ask God to order the footsteps of the righteous, to guard the feet of his Church that we will not stumble or slip.
- c) That He will heal the ears of the church from the songs of the politicians and intimidation tunes of the wicked.
- d) That God of all flesh will create obedience in the hearts of His own, that as Peter followed the instruction of the angel of God, that we too will heed to his voice and follow Him and Him alone.
- e) Ask God to remove from his Church the garments of shame, dishonor, and all filthiness. Clothe her with new priestly garments of honor, righteousness, compassion, mercy etc.
- f) Pray against the influence of the spirit of fear, witchcraft, men and deception. Pray that the word of God and the Holy Spirit will have greater influence here than men.
- g) Pray for the Ekklesia in Kenya and in the world, not to turn away from God again. Pray to God the giver of life to keep us alive that we may continue to praise Him. *Ps.80:18*

SUNDAY 27TH DEC. 2020: NATION UNDER GOD

“Although the Lord gives you the bread of adversity and water of affliction, your teachers will be hidden no more; with your own eyes, you will see them. Whether you turn to the right of to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you saying, this is the way; walk in it. (Isa. 30: 21-22)

- a) Welcome the Manifest Presence of Jesus into your home, your congregation and the nation at large.
- b) Pray that his light that shines forth in darkness will shine forth in the land and the darkness will retreat giving way for the revealing of the sons of God.
- c) Pray that God will raise champions for his kingdom in every county who will be trained and resourced and will move in the power of the Holy Spirit to dedicate the counties and their leadership to the Lordship of Jesus Christ.
- d) Pray and ask God to break every yoke of idolatry, tribalism, immorality, false religion, poverty, new age, corruption etc over the people in this land.
- e) Dedicate the people, resources and the land of Kenya to the Lord God Almighty.



- f) Pray and ask God to water this land with His fear and the knowledge of His will. Ask Him to tender and nurture this land, shepherd people to His plans and purposes.

- g) Pray that the Political class in this nation will yield themselves to the leadership of Jesus and change their focus from self-preservation to serving the people

- h) Praise Adonay YAWHEH for great is his love to the people and he will show his mercy once again.
